
2. That the forms listed above were filed late.
3. That the failure to file the foregoing forms timely represents fourteen (14) separate violations of 39-A M.R.S.A. §360(1)(B).

WHEREFORE, pursuant to 39-A M.R.S.A. §360(1)(B), Sentry Insurance shall pay a civil forfeiture of \$100.00 for each of the foregoing eleven (11) unpaid violations for a total penalty of \$1,100.00, payable to Treasurer, State of Maine. The penalty payment shall be sent to the to the attention of Mr. Steven Minkowsky, Deputy Director of Benefits Administration, Workers' Compensation Board, 27 State House Station, Augusta, Maine 04333-0027.


