Pursuant to Section 4.4 of the Surf Point Foundation Trust Agreement, dated April 7, 1988 (the "Agreement"), the undersigned, being all of the Trustees (the "Trustees") of the Surf Point Foundation, under the Agreement (the "Trust"), hereby consent to the taking of, and hereby take, the following actions in the form of the following resolutions, to be effective as of January 19, 2021 (the "Effective Date"):

RESOLVED: That the Trust's distribution and transfer, consistent with Section 6.4 of the Agreement, of all of the Trust's assets, to Surf Point Foundation, a Maine nonprofit corporation formed to carry out the purposes of the Trust (the "Corporation"), pursuant to terms and conditions to be agreed to by the Trust's Executive Director, Trustees, and officers, if any (each, an "Authorized Person," and collectively, the "Authorized Persons"), and each of them, acting singly or jointly, in his, her, or their discretion, be and it hereby is authorized and approved; and that, in connection therewith, the Trust be and it hereby is authorized to enter into and perform under a trustee's deed and bill of sale in favor of the Corporation, an assignment and assumption agreement with the Corporation, and any and all other documents, agreements, instruments, and certificates, in form agreed to by one or more of the Authorized Persons (collectively, the "Transaction Documents"), the entry into and performance under any of which to be conclusive evidence that the same has been authorized and approved by the Trustees.

RESOLVED: That, in connection with the foregoing, and in accordance with law and the Agreement, the Authorized Persons, and each of them, acting singly or jointly, in his, her, or their discretion, be and they hereby are authorized, in the name and on behalf of the Trust, to execute, acknowledge, and deliver the Transaction Documents, the execution, acknowledgment, and delivery of any of which to be conclusive evidence that the same has been authorized and approved by the Trustees.

RESOLVED: That, in connection with the foregoing, the Authorized Persons, and each of them, acting singly or jointly, in, his, her, or their discretion, be and they hereby are authorized and directed, in the name and on behalf of the Trust, to execute, acknowledge, and deliver the Transaction Documents, together with such changes and modifications thereto as any of such Authorized Persons may in his, her, or their discretion approve, such approval to be conclusively evidenced by his, her, or their execution, acknowledgment, and delivery thereof, and to execute, acknowledge, and deliver any and all such further documents, instruments, agreements, and certificates, and to take and do any and all such further actions and things

(including without limitation paying any and all such expenses), as he, she, or they may deem necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes of the foregoing resolutions or any part thereof, such execution, acknowledgment, and delivery of any of which documents, instruments, agreements, and certificates, and the taking and doing of any such other actions and things, to be conclusive evidence that the same has been authorized and approved hereby.

RESOLVED: That any and all acts of the Authorized Persons, which acts would have been authorized by the foregoing resolutions except that such acts were taken prior to the adoption of such resolutions, be and they hereby are severally ratified, confirmed, approved, and adopted in all respects as acts in the name and on behalf of the Trust.

This Consent may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original but together shall constitute one and the same instrument. Any signatures on this Consent transmitted electronically or by facsimile shall be deemed to be original signatures for all purposes. This Consent shall be filed with the records of the meetings of the Trustees.
