**RESOLVED:** That, in connection with the foregoing, the Authorized Persons, and each of them, acting singly or jointly, in his, her, or their discretion, be and they hereby are authorized and directed, in the name and on behalf of the Trust, to execute, acknowledge, and deliver the Transaction Documents, together with such changes and modifications thereto as any of such Authorized Persons may in his, her, or their discretion approve, such approval to be conclusively evidenced by his, her, or their execution, acknowledgment, and delivery thereof, and to execute, acknowledge, and deliver any and all such further documents, instruments, agreements, and certificates, and to take and do any and all such further actions and things




