Onion Foundation Spring/Fall Cycle Grants are intended to support organizations or projects that align with the Foundation's mission priority areas of Arts & Environment within the state of Maine. In 2022 the Onion Foundation is giving organizations the option of requesting general operating funds based on the experiences of our nonprofit partners. The organization and/or the project must be based in Maine and focused on benefitting Maine's people; the Foundation will also typically only award grants to organizations that align with the Foundation's mission and values. Grant recipients are required to report progress on their projects. Spring & Fall Cycle Grants range between \$5,000 and \$20,000. Organizations are eligible to receive one Spring or Fall grant per calendar year.

The Onion Foundation's Discovery grants are intended for small scale projects in the arts or environment that align with the mission and priorities of the Foundation that may lead to a discovery - a new learning or innovative approach. Discovery Grant Projects must: be a new project; not yet started; respond to an unforeseen challenge or opportunity; promote development, equity, inclusion, diversity, and justice; be small in scale; start and end within the next year; and address specific community needs and benefits.
