Conferences and Meetings

<p>Theater with Presenters Table</p> <p>Greatest capacity for attendees in a space.</p>	<p>Theater with presentation panel</p> <p>Default set up plus a head table for a panel of 3-5 people. Minimal capacity reduction.</p>	<p>Classroom Style</p> <p>Ideal for lectures and courses where attendees benefit from real-time review of course materials. Reduces spacing capacity in half.</p>
<p>Seated Rounds</p> <p>Best for those needing catering or setting up workshops.</p>	<p>Head table for A/V, side tables, circle of inward facing chairs</p> <p>Best for interactive sessions. Subject to day of service charges for changeovers, depending on space.</p>	<p>Meeting</p> <p>Best for private meetings, focus groups, etc. Subject to day of service charges for changeovers, depending on space.</p>
