

The Maine Board of Pesticides Control cordially invites you to an **Agricultural Basic Pesticide Applicator License** training course on Wednesday, October 23, 2024, at the Sherman Town Office.

The training will begin at 8:30 AM and continue to 11:30 AM.

An opportunity to take the Ag Basic Core Exam will follow immediately after the training.

For applicators seeking pesticide credits, the program is worth three credits.

Seating is limited.

The training and exam are free. However, people taking the exam are asked to provide proof of identity.

Please be aware that Maine State law requires that people who annually sell more than \$1,000 of plants or plant products intended for human consumption and only general-use (over-the-counter) pesticides obtain an Agricultural Basic pesticide applicator license.

Plants or plant products intended for human consumption include:

- Growers of fruits, vegetables, herbs and grains for human consumption
- Growers of the above crops who make bread, jam, French fries, wine, cider, juice, etc., or who sell products to be processed into those products
- Greenhouse growers selling fruit, vegetable and herb seedlings.
