**Third Quarterly Study Progress Report** 

Dear Secretary Bose:

Rumford Falls Hydro LLC (RFH), a subsidiary of Brookfield Renewable, herein submits to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC or Commission) the third quarterly study progress report for the Rumford Falls Hydroelectric Project (Project) (FERC No. 2333) in accordance with 18 CFR §5.15(b). The Project is a two-development hydroelectric facility on the Androscoggin River in the Town of Rumford, Oxford County, Maine. The FERC license for the Project expires on September 30, 2024 and RFH is pursuing a new license for the Project through the Commission's Integrated Licensing Process (ILP).

Consistent with the ILP and 18 CFR §5.13, RFH filed the Revised Study Plan (RSP) with the Commission on July 7, 2020. The Commission issued a Study Plan Determination (SPD) on August 6, 2020. Consistent with the RSP and associated SPD, RFH will be conducting a total of eight studies. On January 29, 2021, RFH filed the second quarterly study progress report with the Commission. The enclosed table provides updates that have occurred since the submittal of the second quarterly study progress report. The available results from these studies will be presented in the Initial Study Report, which will be filed with the FERC on August 7, 2021. As a result, RFH does not anticipate filing a quarterly study progress report with the Commission in August 2021.

In addition to filing this third quarterly study report with the Commission, RFH is distributing this letter to those on the enclosed distribution list.
