BOARD ORDER

IN THE MATTER OF

CHARLES GILLESPIE CUMBERLAND SEPTIC TANK SERVICE North Yarmouth #00-3015-05150 Septic Tank and Cesspool Waste Disposal Sites

FINDINGS OF FACT AND ORDER

After reviewing the project file and related materials submitted with regard to the above noted application under provisions of Title 30, Sections 4104 and 4105, the Board finds the following facts:

- 1. Disposal of septic wastes at this site will not contaminate any bodies of water, water supplies, or groundwater.
- 2. Disposal of septic wastes at this site will not contaminate any bodies of water, water supplies, or groundwater.

THEREFORE, The Board approves the application of Charles Gillespie-Cumberland Septic Tank Service to operate this site according to the criteria of the "Maine Guidelines for Septic Sludge Disposal On The Land", limited to the location identified in the application, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Septage disposal shall be limited to Site A identified in the application.
- 2. Septage loading shall not exceed 18,500 gallons per acre per year, and 20,000 gallons per year.
- Septage disposal shall be by the uniform spreading method. Sufficient vegetation shall be removed to facilitate movement of the septage disposal vehicle over the site to allow spreading.
- 4. An annual tabulation of the volume of septage delivered to the site shall be presented to the Department of Environmental Protection on or before November 1 of each year.
- 5. Signs shall be posted around the perimeter of the site reading "Hazard-Keep Out-Septage Disposal Site".
- 6. Applicant shall develop and submit for approval optional plans for the control of odor which may develop on this site including, but not limited to, such actions as harrowing, chlorination, plowing under, or liming. Such plans shall be implemented upon a determination by the Commissioner that an odor problem is being created.
