BOARD ORDER

IN THE MATTER OF

Septic Tank and Cesspool Waste Disposal Site

FINDINGS OF FACT AND ORDER

Project Number: 00-3455-31270

After reviewing the project file and related materials submitted with regard to the above noted application under provisions of Title 30, Sections 4104 and 4105, the Board finds the following facts:

- Disposal of septic wastes at this site will not contaminate any bodies of water, water supplies, or groundwater.
- Disposal of septic wastes at this site will not constitute a hazard to health or safety or create a nuisance to any person.

THEREFORE, The Board approves the application of Darling's A-1 Service Inc. to operate this site according to the criteria of the "Maine Guidelines For Septic Sludge Disposal On The Land", limited to the location identified in the application subject to the following terms and conditions:

The Standard Conditions of Approval, a copy attached.

1) Septic tank sludge disposal shall not exceed 18,500 gallons per acre per year. The applicant shall develop a program of groundwater and soil water monitoring

acceptable to the Department. No septage disposal shall occur prior to installation of monitoring devices.

Septage disposal shall be by the uniform spreading method. The proposed area

shall be cleared of trees to facilitate the land spreading operation.

4) Signs shall be posted around the perimeter of the site reading "Hazard-Keep Out-Septic Tank Sludge Disposal Site".

5) An annual tabulation of the volume of septage delivered to the site shall be

presented to the Department on or before November 1 of each year.

Evaluation by the Department of the data generated by the groundwater and soil water monitoring program shall determine whether further septage disposal shall be permitted. Such evaluations shall be made at least once each year.
