

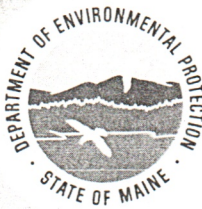

Project Number 00-4070-29370) FINDINGS OF FACT AND ORDER

After reviewing the project file and related materials submitted with regard to the above noted application under provisions of Title 38, Section 1320 and 1321, the Board finds the following facts:

1. Disposal of septic wastes at this site will not contaminate any bodies of water, water supplies, or groundwater.
2. Disposal of septic wastes at this site will not constitute a hazard to health or safety or create a nuisance to any person.

THEREFORE, The Board approves the application of the Town of Princeton to operate this site according to the criteria of the "Maine Guidelines For Septic Sludge Disposal On The Land", limited to the location identified in the application, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The Standard Conditions of Approval, a copy attached.
2. Septage disposal shall be by the conditions presented in "Conditions for Repeated annual use of a Disposal Site For Septic Tank Waste", presented in the Guidelines. Copy attached.
3. Septage disposal shall not exceed 18,500 gallons per acre per year.
4. An annual tabulation of the volume of waste delivered to the site shall be presented to the Department on or before November 1 of each year.
5. The applicant shall provide a suitable method for septage disposal for the winter months, subject to Department approval.
