
I am writing on behalf of Linkletter & Sons Inc. regarding Blue Sky East, LLC's Bingham wind power project, which is proposed to be located on Linkletter land in Kingsbury Plantation and the Town of Parkman.

The land in question is actively managed commercial timberland. Our understanding is that the Bingham project will include the construction and improvement of roads on our property. The attached map depicts the project roads to be built or improved on Linkletter land.
