I am writing on behalf of Plum Creek Maine Timberlands, LLC regarding Blue Sky East, LLC's Bingham wind power project, which is proposed to be located on Plum Creek land in Kingsbury Plantation, Mayfield Township, and the Towns of Bingham and Moscow.

The land in question is actively managed commercial timberland. Our understanding is that the Bingham project will include the construction and improvement of roads on our property. The attached map depicts the project roads to be built or improved on Plum Creek land.

This roadwork will benefit our land by providing additional access to forest resources that are important to our commercial operation.

As such, we request that the roads constructed on Plum Creek land as part of the Bingham project remain in place after the project has been decommissioned.
