Spinney - Appeal of NRPA permit for boat ramp and pier system

Ms. Collins and Mr. Spinney:

This email pertains to the status of the pending appeals of Mr. Spinney's permit for a boat ramp and pier system on the Sheepscot River.

The Board was scheduled to consider this appeal at its meeting on August 20, 2020. Prior to that meeting, Mr. Spinney requested a 60 day continuance. Following consultation with Board counsel and Department staff and given no objection from the appellants, the Board Chair granted the continuance for up to 60 days, until Monday, October 12, 2020. I note that October 12 is a holiday and State office will be closed, therefore, the deadline for a response is Tuesday, October 13, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.

As stated in Chair Draper's August 13, 2020 letter, unless the Department receives a request to revise the response to the appeal with an alternative proposal for the project by that date, the Board will resume processing of the appeals of the existing permit.
