Thank you for the additional comments. These will be added to our record.

Regarding the dimensions of the pier system, which you mention in your comments, the revised plans dated December 9, 2019 represent a reduction in overall shading impacts from the seasonal ramp and float. The seasonal ramp width is still four feet. The additional five feet of length for the ramp is located largely over the upland to reach the pilings and decking which has been moved back from the coastal wetland. The length of the landing float was reduced from 16 to seven feet. The main float was reduced from 8' x 32' to 8' x 24'. These changes reduce the proposed shading impact by approximately 100 square feet. The revised plans are attached for reference.

Your other concerns will be considered during the Department's review.
