SECTION 25 NOTICES

The Applicant has provided all necessary public notices to abutting property owners, the local municipality office, and to a newspaper, which is circulated in the area where the Project is located.

On November 3, 2023, a Public Informational Meeting (PIM)notice (Exhibit 25-1) was sent to all abutting property owners and the Town of Hartland (local municipality, Town). A list of the abutting property owners is provided in Table 25-1 and the relative location of each abutting parcel is depicted in Figure 25-1. United States Postal Service Certified Mail Receipts are provided in Exhibit 25-2. The public notice also was published in the *Morning Sentinel* newspaper that is distributed in the area where the Project is located on November 4, 2023 (Exhibit 25-3), and provided to the Town, to be posted on the community bulletin board available in the Town office and on the Town's website.

A PIM was held on November 16, 2023, in accordance with MDEP rules (06-096 CMR 2). Twenty-five members of the public, Town of Hartland, or State agencies attended the public meeting. The Applicant presented information summarizing the Project civil design and location, the avoidance and minimization of environmental impacts, permits that will be obtained prior to Project construction, permitting and construction schedule and the MDEP public participation and the MDEP public participation process as described in the MDEP fact sheet. The meeting sign-in sheet and certification form (Form C) are provided in Exhibit 25-4.

On January 22, 2024, a Notice of Intent to file (Exhibit 25-5) was sent to abutters and to the local municipality. United States Postal Service Certified Mail Receipts are provided in Exhibit 25-6. A public Notice of Intent to file was circulated in the *Morning Sentinel* newspaper, on January 23, 2024 (Exhibit 25-7). A copy of the Notice of Intent to file also was provided to the Town to be posted on the community bulletin board available at the Town Office and on the Town's website.

As the project progressed, the Applicant and/or its representatives provided updates at selectmen's meetings and responded to questions and suggestions. A PowerPoint presentation was made on August 2, 2021, and again on July 17, 2023, followed by questions and answers.

On October 5, 2023, Teichos Energy hosted an Open House meeting. Notice of the meeting was mailed to the project abutters and all residents and P.O. box holders in Hartland. The first half of the two-hour forum consisted of a poster session with subject matter experts followed by a PowerPoint presentation and Q&A session.

Over the past 2.5 years, Teichos Energy has learned a lot about the needs and values of the town, while residents and officials have had a front row seat on how an application for a utility-scale project comes together. The insight and relationships that have developed will be critical to the ultimate success of the Project.
