Hi Maria,

The applicant needs to provide estimates of the quantities of all wastes expected to be produced. I see an estimate for MSW, but not for the other materials. The hauler(s) will need to be identified and hold nonhazardous waste transporter licenses where applicable, and the transfer station and disposal facilities intended to be used must be identified. Contracts or other demonstration of commitment to use the specified facilities must be included. It's not clear what exactly might go to Exeter Agri-Energy (fish processing by-products or fish poop or something else); Kingfish should have a backup plan in case the material isn't acceptable for anaerobic digestion. The application mentions that some fish processing by-products may be resold or sent to off-site processing facilities; I'll need quantities and destinations for that also.

I have had only preliminary discussions with Kingfish regarding beneficial use of dredge material. I'll keep you posted on that.
