# Know all men by these Presents,

That I, FRANK E. DEAN of Livermore Falls, Androscoggin County, Maine,

in consideration of One Dollar and other valuable consideration

the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey, unto the said

CENTRAL SECURITIES CORPORATION

Its Successors - Heirs and Assigns forever,  
A certain lot or parcel of land in the town of Livermore Falls, Androscoggin County, Maine, nearly triangular in form and bounded northerly by land now or formerly of Caroline M. Jones; easterly by the Severy lot, so-called; southerly by the Treat Memorial Cemetery, so-called, (about 14 feet); westerly by a line parallel with and three hundred thirty-seven and one-half (337 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet westerly of a survey line now staked out across said Severy lot and said Jones lot. Containing about two and one-half (2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) acres.

My title to the above property is derived by deed from Ella M. Keep, et al., by deed dated January 20, 1912 and recorded in Androscoggin Registry, Book 241, Page 463.

Reserving to the grantor herein, the wood and lumber on said parcel, said wood and lumber to be removed by the grantor on written request of the grantee. Or, if not removed by the grantor in season to avoid interference with construction or maintenance work, the grantee may cut and remove said wood and lumber at its option.
