THIS AGREEMENT made this trenty-third day of August 1930, BY AND BETWEEN:

CENTRAL SECURITIES CORPORATION, of Augusta, Kennebec County, Maine, hereinafter called the "Corporation";

E. Benner Town or City of Anson State of hereinafter called the "Licensee", WITNESSETH THAT:

Whereas the Corporation has purchased a certain strip of land from the Licensee and the continued use of said strip of land by the Licensee appears advantageous to both parties,

NOW THEREFORE:

It is mutually agreed as follows:-

- That in consideration of the covenants herein contained on the part of the Licensee to be kept and performed by him or her (or by him and her), the Corporation hereby grants permission to the Licensee to use said strip of land for agricultural purposes.
- The Licensee shall not assign the rights herein granted to any person, firm or corporation without the written consent of the Corporation.
- 3. The rights herein granted by the Corporation to the Licensee shall in no way interfere with the use of said strip of land by the Corporation or its successors or assigns in connection with the construction, operation and maintenance of electric transmission lines along and/or across said strip of land,
- This Agreement shall take effect at the date hereof and shall continue in force until either of the parties hereto shall fix the date of the termination thereof by a written notice of one hundred and fifty (150) days prior to said date of termination to the other party hereto.
- 5. The Licensee shall indemnify, protect and save harmless the Corporation from and against all claims, suits, costs, charges and damages made upon or incurred by the Corporation in connection with this License.
- In consideration of this License the Licensee shall pay to the Corporation the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) per year or fraction thereof, beginning January 1, 1931 and subsequent payments to be made on the first day of August in each year during the continuation of this Agreement.
- 7.
