A strip of land 200 feet in width extending from land now or formerly of Arthur J. Jean southerly to land now or formerly of Clyde S. Fowle. Said strip being bounded northerly by said Jean lot; easterly by a line parallel with and 75 feet easterly of the survey line now staked out across this lot, the Jean lot and the Fowle lot; southerly by said Fowle lot; westerly by a line parallel with and 125 feet westerly of the survey line above described.
