## KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

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That I, THOMAS M. FOX

of Whitefield, County of Lincoln and State of Maine, in consideration of one dollar and other valuable consideration paid by CENTRAL MAINE POWER COMPANY, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Maine and having an office and place of business at Augusta, County or Kennebec, said State of Maine, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Central Maine Power Company, its successors and assigns, forever, a certain lot or parcel of land in the town of Whitefield, County of Lincoln , State of Maine, bounded and described as follows:

A strip of land 200 feet in width extending from land now or formerly of Peter P. Field southerly to land now or formerly of the Town of Whitefield. Said strip being bounded northerly by said Field lot; easterly by a line parallel with and 75 feet easterly of the survey line now staked out across this lot, the Field lot and the Town of Whitefield lot; southerly by said Town of Whitefield lot; westerly by a line parallel with and 125 feet westerly of the survey line above described.
