in consideration of one dollar and other valuable consideration paid by CENTRAL MAINE POWER COMPANY, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Maine and having an office and place of business at Augusta, County of Kennebec, said State of Maine, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Central Maine Power Company, its successors and assigns, forever, certain lot(s) or parcel(s) of land in the town (xitx) of Wiscasset , County of Lincoln State of Maine, bounded and described as follows:

Being a strip of land 85 feet in width extending from land of Leander B. Nichols on the south in a northerly direction to land of Abreham Wanser, et al, on the northeast.

Said strip is bounded westerly and northwesterly by a strip of land 200 feet in width conveyed to the Grantee by Oscar N. Main by deed dated January 14, 1941 and by the Grantor by deed dated January 25, 1941, said deeds being recorded in Lincoln County Registry of Deeds in Book 439, Page 544 and Book 433, Page 331, respectively; and bounded easterly and southeasterly by a line parallel with and 85 feet distant easterly and southeasterly of the easterly and southeasterly line of said 200-foot strip.

The right of the Grantor, his heirs and assigns, to cut and remove said standing wood and timber is subject to the prior right of the Grantee, its successors and assigns, at any time or from time to time to clear and keep clear said premises of all trees, timber and bushes growing thereon by such means as the Grantee, its successors and assigns, may select. The Grantor, his heirs and assigns, shall be entitled to any salvage of the wood and timber cut by the Grantee, its successors and assigns, and/or its contractors, for a period of one (1) year from the date said premises or any part thereof shall first be cleared.

Excepting and reserving to the Grantor herein, his heirs and assigns, the right to cross the above described strip on foot and with vehicles at such times and such places as will not in any way interfere with any use that the Grantee, its successors and assigns, may hereafter make of said strip in connection with carrying on its business as a public utility.
