Said parcel is more particularly bounded and described as follows: On the south by land now or formerly of Kenneth Seigers, et al, now of this Grantee; on the west by said Mountain Road; and on the north by land of this Grantee and land now or formerly of Marguerite Colby Fairs; and on the east by said Montsweag Brook.
