Air Emissions



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21.1 State Standards

Pursuant to the State's Site Law, applicants shall identify all sources of emissions from the development of the project.

21.2 Air Emissions Assessment

The Project is not expected to have an adverse effect on air quality. During construction of the proposed Project, there will be temporary and minor air emissions generated by construction equipment and vehicle exhaust. The construction site will be monitored for dust, and mitigation procedures will be implemented, as needed.

During operations, the Project is not expected to adversely affect air quality. The Project will generate and deliver electricity to the New England grid without generating emissions.

Maintenance vehicles will access the Project area periodically over unpaved roads but will not generate enough traffic to cause substantial emissions of exhaust or dust. No emission sources associated with the operation of the Project will require an air permit.

The Project will be constructed and operated in compliance with the Site Location of Development Act's No Adverse Environmental Effect Standards, 06-096 CMR 375.1 (No Unreasonable Adverse Effect on Air Quality).
