In addition, I have used electric vehicles at my job with the state of Maine. Their ability to drive any substantial distance for committing, especially in the winter is prohibitive. We are currently in the process of getting rid of our Nissan leaf electric vehicle at my bureau as we cannot even drive from Augusta to Orono with it.

Lastly, there is a lack of charging stations and our electricity grid cannot handle the increased charging capacity required. Just look at California as an example.
