
Respiratory Health


Chronic respiratory diseases include chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) and asthma, and affects approximately one in eight people in Maine. COPD is largely a result of tobacco smoke and primarily affects older adults. Asthma affects people of all ages and is increasing in Maine at a dramatic rate.

Data on chronic lower respiratory disease [includes COPD] and on asthma are collected through Maine vital records, hospital data, and state surveys.
