

Get Started

Download the BNFT app to your mobile device. Creating an account is easy! When setting up your account you will need: email address(username), eWIC card number, birthdate and your mailing zipcode. When you are ready to make a purchase, select "Farmer's Market Barcode" and display your screen to the farmer to complete your purchase! If you do not have access to a mobile device, you can also visit mybnft.com and print off a barcode, which can be brought to the market. Be sure to pay close attention to the expiration date on printed

On July 1st, participants over the age of 1 will be issued \$50 for the Farmer's Market Season! In addition, you can also use your monthly fruit and vegetable cash value benefit (CVB) year-round. If your purchase exceeds the \$50 provided for FMNP, the additional charge will be deducted from the available CVB balance. If your purchase exceeds both FMNP and CVB you will be required to use another form of tender.

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Be sure to download the BNFT app prior to your visit to the Farmers Market. This will save you time at check out!
- Walk through the market prior to making your purchase. See what's available for produce and compare prices.
- Be sure to bring your re-useable bag. Stop by your local WIC office if you don't have one!
- To keep your account safe, the BNFT app will require you to enter a code 1x/week. To ensure you do not become locked from your account, be sure the phone number entered is correct before requesting your code by text or phone call.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Where can I use my farmer's market benefit? Participating farms that are listed in this brochure accept WIC FMNP via the BNFT app. You can also see a current list of farmers on the WIC Shopper App and by scanning the barcode on this brochure.
- What can I buy with eFMNP?

Maine grown fruits and vegetables.

What is not available with eFMNP?

Plants, seedlings, flowers, meat, eggs, cheese, bread, jam, jelly or prepared items and anything not grown in Maine.

 Can this be used with other benefits such as SNAP?

Some markets will also accept Maine Harvest Bucks and many have their own programs that offer additional benefits to eligible participants! Be sure to ask at your local Market or Farm Stand!
