Subject: MENHADEN: Update on Quota Consumption and Best Harvest Practices

Notice to all Menhaden Harvesters:

Maine's adjusted 2024 allocation is **23,950,712 pounds**. The commercial fishery opened on Monday, June 17th, with approximately 189 harvesters landing 1,780,136 pounds in a single day. As of yestserday, total menhaden landings are **4,688,245 pounds with 283 harvesters reporting** (including both commercial and non-commercial). The Episodic Set Aside remains at 5.1 million pounds. As a reminder, other states can request fish from this Set Aside once they have harvested their commercial quota.

Menhaden are more abundant than last year, and we are harvesting at a faster pace. That said, the Department has not yet made a decision on whether to pause the fishery. We will continue to communicate with the industry as harvest progresses.

Important Reminders:

In light of the high abundance of menhaden in our waters, the Department reminds harvesters that menhaden is not a resource to be callously wasted. Do not fish without a market. Harvesting menhaden in excess and knowingly not having a direct sale prepared negatively impacts potential bait availability in later months. It shouldn't have to be re-stated that all efforts should be made to fish sustainability to avoid dumping or loss of fish. Please call Marine Patrol if you see fish being wasted.

The Department has received calls that bait storage is filling up. Please fish responsibly.
