BRIEF SUMMARY: On June 10, 2023, DMR adopted an emergency rule to expand an existing area on the Saco River closed to fishing. DMR is proposing to adopt this same rule as regular rule-making. Consistent with the emergency rule, this proposal would modify Maine's Gear Restriction Regulation, Chapter 55.99 to close the waters of the Saco River upstream of the Route 9/Main Street bridge between Factory Island, Saco and Mechanics Park, Biddeford, to the head of tide. This is necessary to prevent high levels of catch and release mortality observed this season and which negatively impacts the striped bass resource.

## **CHAPTER 55 GEAR RESTRICTIONS**

55.99 Fishing in the Saco River above the footbridge Route 9/Main Street bridge between Saco and Biddeford

It shall be unlawful to fish <del>on</del> the waters of the Saco River <del>from the</del> upstream <del>side</del> of the <del>footbridge</del> <del>Route 9/Main Street bridge</del> between <u>Factory Island</u>, Saco and <u>Mechanics Park</u>, Biddeford, <del>upstream</del> to the head of tide, commonly known as the "Cataract Dam".

ANALYSIS AND EXPECTED OPERATION OF THE RULE: [*see* §8057-A(1)(B)&(D)] By expanding the area closed to fishing, it is anticipated that catch and release mortality on striped bass will be reduced, benefiting the striped bass resource and improving the likelihood of rebuilding.

This proposal considered action taken at the May 2, 2023 Atlantic Striped Bass Board meeting, including technical analysis on updated probabilities of rebuilding, motions made at the meeting, input from anglers regarding observed mortalities, and input from Maine Marine Patrol.
