


Assessment Team Monthly Update June 2024

Spring 2024 SAU Data Clean-Up

The spring 2024 administration window closed on May 31. Please see the <u>SAU Data Clean-Up Checklist</u> for a list of tasks to be completed during the SAU data clean-up period from June 3 through June 7.

Student Score Data File and Individual Student Reports

Maine Through Year Assessment scores are only considered final when the assessment window has closed and data analyses are complete. Although we do not anticipate any impacts to scores during data analysis, it is

possible for there to be adjustments, for example due to a "problem question" being removed from students' score calculations.

As a result, the Student Score Data File (SSDF), which contains the final results for the SAU, will become available on July 15. You will locate this file under "Operational Reports" in Acacia. Please note that the SSDF can only be generated at the SAU-level, not the school-level.

The Individual Student Reports, which must be shared with families, become available in Acacia on July 22.

NAEP NEWS

As of this date, no schools in Maine have been selected for any of the NAEP activities for the 2024 – 2025 academic year. Please complete any survey requests regarding last year's assessments and/or technology at your SAU and schools.

Maine has representation on each of the NAEP Technology Advisory Panels. The NAEP School Technology Advisory Panel and the NAEP District Technology Panel will provide the National Center for Education Statistics critical information for the transition of the administration of NAEP on school devices. Findings and recommendations from these panels will be provided as the information becomes available.

The NAEP 2024 results release will be delayed due to the additional analyses required by the transitional to school Wi-Fi. If you have any questions about the NAEP administration or the upcoming release of the results, please contact Dr. Regina Lewis at regina.lewis@maine.gov or 207-530-1355.

Notable changes for future NAEP administrations:

- The transition to school devices will begin with the 2026 administration of the NAEP assessments.
 Schools with Windows and/or Chrome based devices will administer the NAEP in a similar manner as other state assessments.
 - The transition to school devices will take place over multiple administrations. During the transition, NAEP devices will be provided when and where they are needed.
- The NAEP 2026 Mathematics and Reading assessments have updated frameworks and new items. More details on the updated frameworks will be provided as the transition approaches.
