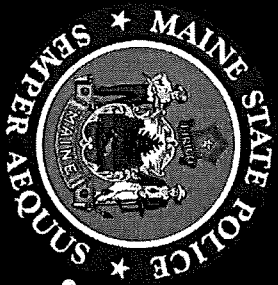
Events Leading up to October 25th, 2023

- October 2022 – Robert Card meets
- December 2022 – Robert Card and end relationship
- February 2023 – Robert Card reportedly hearing voices as reported by his family
- February 2023 – stated that Robert stopped going to Schemengees for Friday night cornhole
- June 2023 – received a message from Robert Card stating that he was hearing that others were saying he was attracted to her kids



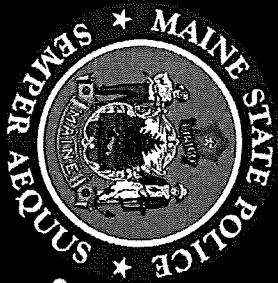
Events Leading up to October 25th, 2023

- July 15, 2023 – Robert Card has an incident with members of his military unit while drilling at West Point
- July 16, 2023 – Robert Card is hospitalized for 14 days in NY because he threatened someone in his military unit.
- September 15, 2023 – Sagadahoc Sheriff's Office receives a complaint from the National Guard to do a well-being check on Robert Card – see SSO Reports.
- September 16, 2023 – Sagadahoc Sheriff's Office visit Robert Card's residence, hears him inside and leaves – see SSO Reports.



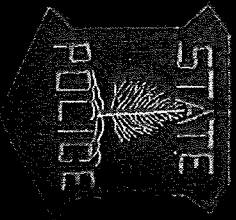
Events Leading up to October 25th, 2023

- September 17, 2023 – Robert Card punched Sean in the face because he believed Sean had made a social media post about him being a pedophile
- September 17, 2023 – Robert Card receives a text from
 - “ ” indicating they need to talk because the Sheriff called and he wanted to talk with Robert about choices he may have
- September 17, 2023 – Robert Card receives a text from
 - “ ”: “Can u call me so I can tell u what the sheriff said? Your going to be taken in for evaluation if you don't secure your firearms. I'm willing to...

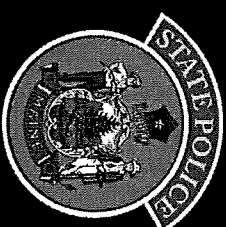


Events Leading up to October 25th, 2023

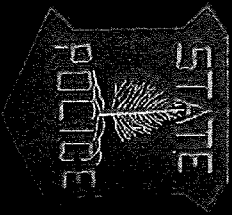
- September 21, 2023 – Sagadahoc SO initiates a File 6 missing person teletype
- October 22, 2023 – A note on Robert Card's cell phone where he wrote about issues he is having, that he has had enough and is trained to hurt people.



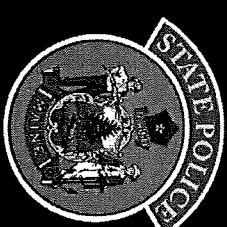
Initial Response and Assignments October 25th



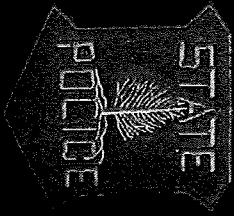
- 7:13 pm Sgt. Farley is notified of the shooting and begins the Major Crimes Response to lead the investigation
- 7:32 pm Sgt. Farley requests MCU North to assist with the investigation
- 7:42 pm Sgt. Farley contacts the on-call Assistant Attorney General who is notified that there are multiple fatalities and the suspect is not in custody
- 7:44 pm Sgt. Farley contacts the Evidence Response Team who is requested to respond to Lewiston to assist with Crime Scene Processing



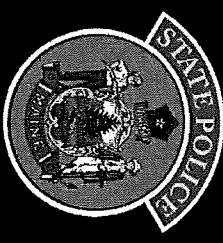
Initial Response – Situational Awareness October 25th



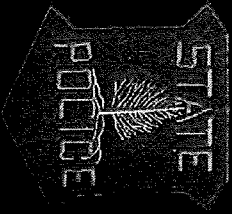
- 7:51 pm a call is received that there is an active shooter at Davinci's restaurant in Lewiston
- 8:06 pm photo of the suspect is released to the media
- 8:11 pm a call is received that there is an active shooter at the Walmart Distribution Center
- 9:18 pm MCU confirmed 7 deceased at Just In Time Bowling
- 9:20 pm Cumberland County Sheriff's Office begins interviewing witnesses at the Lewiston Armory at the request of the Maine State Police



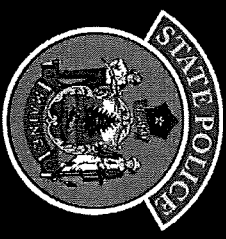
Initial Response and Suspect Identification October 25th



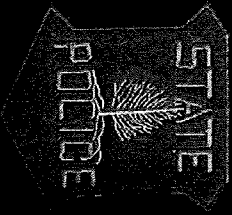
- 9:26 pm a call is received from a family member that the suspect in the photo was Robert Card
- 9:28 pm MCU begins interviewing family members who confirm that the suspect was Robert Card
- 9:29 pm phone records for Robert Card were requested
- 9:33 pm location information for Robert Card's phone show the device in the Bowdoin area in the proximity of his home
- 9:46 pm MCU continues to interview Robert Card's immediate family



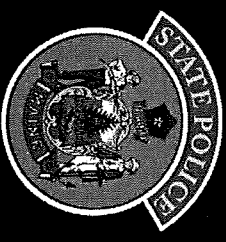
Initial Response and Vehicle Discovery October 25th



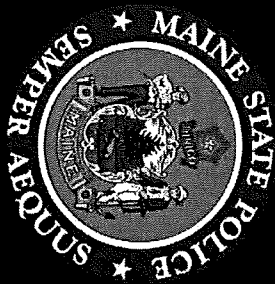
- 9:47 pm MCU confirm there are 8 deceased at Schemengees
- 9:56 pm Lisbon Police report that they have found the vehicle at the boat launch near Frost Hill Ave.
- 10:00 pm MCU confirm there are 3 deceased and 12 injured at CMMC in Lewiston. 1 additional injured is at St. Mary's Hospital. (1 from CMMC is being transported to MMC)
- 10:00 pm Further analysis on Robert Card's device records reveal that his phone remained in the area of West Road in Bowdoin from 6:03 pm to present



Phone Records, Briefings and Interviews October 25th



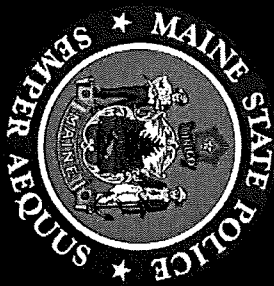
- 10:03 pm Robert Card's family arrive at the Lewiston Police Department to be interviewed
- 10:58 pm Portland Police interview the victim who was transported to MMC
- 11:00 pm Maine State Police MCU conduct the first briefing at the Lewiston Police Department
- 11:30 pm MCU begins to interview friends and associates of Robert Card



Investigation and Notifications October 26th



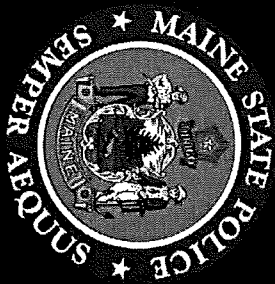
- 12:24 am MCU begins interviews with the injured victims at CMMC
- 1:07 am MCU confirms with the Office of Chief Medical Examiner the total number of deceased and the Medical Examiner begin their response to the Command Post
- 1:30 am approximately 70 interviews of witnesses at the armory completed by Cumberland County Sheriff's Office
- 2:00 am MCU holds an investigative briefing at the Lewiston Police Department. Notifications of the deceased to the families begin at CMMC



Interviews, Vehicles and Victim ID October 26th



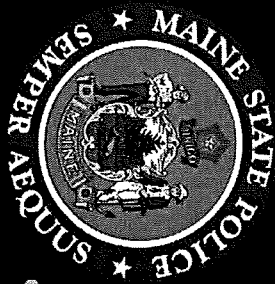
- 2:12 am MCU Detectives are reviewing new leads and tips
- 2:57 am MCU interview more family and friends of Robert Card in Bowdoin
- 3:05 am Robert Card's vehicle is secured at the Maine State Police Crime Laboratory for processing
- 5:15 am MCU is made aware of a white pick-up truck with New Hampshire registration is found at the Schemengees parking area and contains two rifles and numerous magazines unsecured in the front seat
- 5:41 am All but one male have been positively identified at Just In Time Bowling



Interviews, Briefings and Warrants October 26th



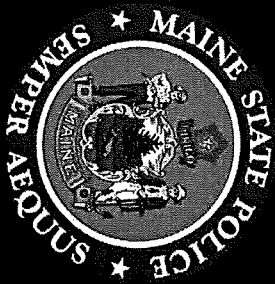
- 6:31 am MCU locates and interviews Robert Card's ex-girlfriend
- 8:00 am MCU participates in the General Briefing at the Lewiston High School beginning the first operational cycle
- 8:31 am all victims at Schemengees are positively identified
- 9:38 am search warrant is signed for Robert Card's vehicle and residence
- 10:00 am an arrest warrant is issued for Robert Card's arrest charging him with knowing and intentional murder
- 10:50 am Search Warrant is served at Robert Card's residence



Briefing and Military Interviews October 26th



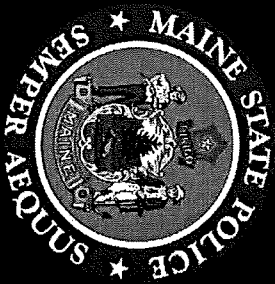
- 3:25 pm Lewiston Police detectives received information that another person may have been involved
- 3:35 pm MCU participates in Investigative Briefing at Lewiston High School
- 4:00 pm Lt. Colonel Scott is contacted by a member of the press asking for comment regarding information released in the last briefing
- 4:02 pm MCU begins interviews with personnel from the military as related to Robert Card's service
- 4:15 pm Robert Card's family give consent to search property on Meadow Road in Bowdoin



Briefing, Crime Scenes and Canvas October 26th



- 7:57 pm Search Warrants were signed for the 2 Crime Scenes - Schemengees and Just In Time Bowling as well as the white pick-up truck in the parking lot at Schemengees
- 8:00 pm MCU participates in a General Briefing at Lewiston High School at the beginning of the 2nd operational cycle
- 8:20 pm MCU and Lewiston PD locate the individual who was stating he was possible involved.
- 8:45 pm MCU conducts neighborhood canvas around Schemengees



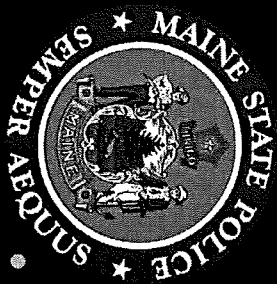
Investigation and Digital Evidence October 26th

- 10:20 pm MCU begins legal process on possible involved individual
- 11:24 pm MCU finishes the interview with the possible involved individual

October 27th

- 12:17 am the Search Warrant for Robert Card's cellular phone was signed
- 2:15 am the MCU receives a report that a person who identifies themselves as Robert Card called a suicide hotline. Investigators conducted surveillance and legal process throughout the night, the call was determined to be hoax

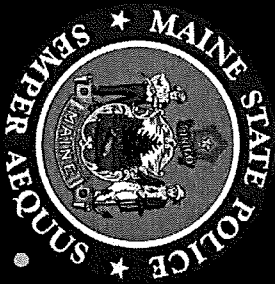




Investigation and Digital Evidence October 27th



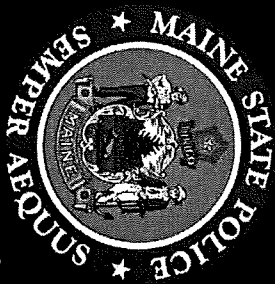
- 5:45 am search warrant is signed for the Facebook Account of the possible involved individual
- 7:45 am MCU is notified that a possible victim from Just In Time bowling may be unaccounted for and it is assigned for follow-up
- 8:00 am MCU participated in the General ICS briefing at the start of this third operational cycle
- 8:30 am New Hampshire MCU locates the registered owner of the white pick-up truck in New Hampshire who reports that he recently sold the truck to one of the injured victims



Investigation and Digital Evidence October 27th



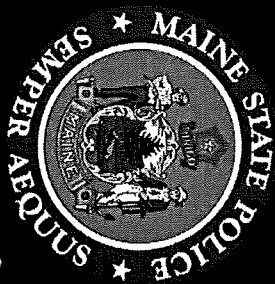
- 9:30 am MCU detectives continue to conduct interviews with friends and family of Robert Card
- 11:30 am HSI Agent and Auburn Police reported that the possible victim unaccounted for had been made up by a local transient
- 1:11 pm MCU re-interviews the possible involved individual who confesses to fabricating the story
- 2:42 pm MCU interviews Robert Card's military supervisors in New Hampshire
- 2:44 pm Search Warrant is signed for Robert Cards cellular phone records



Investigation and Digital Evidence October 27th

- 7:47 pm Robert Card is found deceased in Lisbon
- 8:10 pm Search Warrant is signed for the infotainment system in Robert Card's car
- The investigation has continued since his body was discovered.

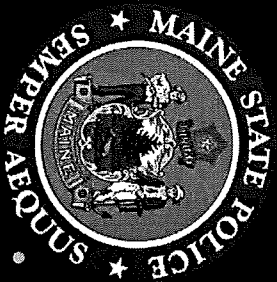




Weapons Used in the Event on October 25th

- July 28th, 2012 - Smith & Wesson MP 40 handgun purchased from Cabelas in Scarborough
- November 16th, 2018 - .223 MP15 rifle purchased from Rideout's Gunworks in Richmond
- July 6th, 2023 - .308 Ruger SFAR Rifle purchased from Fine Line Gun Shop in Poland

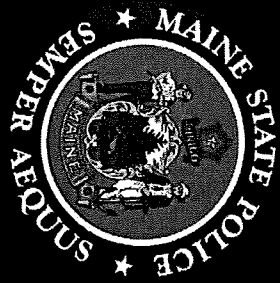




Maine State Police Overall Response Summary



- Over 100 Maine State Troopers responded to Lewiston over the three-day period. This included detectives from all three Major Crimes Units from Kittery to Fort Kent.
- Over 70 Maine State Troopers responded to Lewiston within the first hour
- Over 140 private and commercially owned properties checked for video surveillance
- Over 200 people were interviewed over a two-day period
- To date, this case file is over one terabyte in size for digital data stored
- The lead sheet from the incident command post yielded 821 leads
- In the 24 hours after the shooting the Augusta RCC received 178 calls for service and the Lewiston-Auburn Communications Center received an additional 712
