Subject Notes:

- Card has PTSD and delusions
- Has specifically mentioned several locations where he was accused of being a pedophile
 - NH bakery where Card delivered bread - Card accused them of calling him a pedophile which they hadn't; he said them calling him that may be his reason to snap
- Suicide note mentions desire to play cornhole with girlfriend and desire to be left alone
- Per Maine SP, Card was part of a cornhole and bowling group until February 2023
- There is another individual of the same name on the sex offender registry & people started teasing him that it was him; started hearing voices roughly around this time.

- Sheriff's office recently filed on him for psychotic episodes; Card was committed to a mental facility for two weeks in summer 2023
- Previously threatened to shoot up the National Guard armory in Saco, ME
- US Army Reserves since 20 Dec 2007 – petroleum supply specialist
- Recent contact with military, intent to discharge him
- Holds a Secret clearance as of 2017
- Hard of hearing; has hearing aids
- Employed by Country Kitchen (this is a bakery outlet)
- Vehicle has been seized and is in custody (2013 White Subaru [REDACTED])
- Interest in fishing, has multiple boats and sea-doo's registered to him
- Mom [REDACTED]
- Experiencing what she described as an "acute" mental health episode in the weeks before Wednesday's shooting ([REDACTED] re: Forbes)

Hooks:

- **Military:** never deployed but has been awarded the Army Achievement Medal, Army Reserve Component Achievement Medal, the Humanitarian Service Medal, National Defense Service Medal and Army Service Ribbon (DoD re: Bangor Daily News)
 - Currently a sergeant first class and is a petroleum supply specialist in the Army Reserve (US Army re: Bangor Daily News)

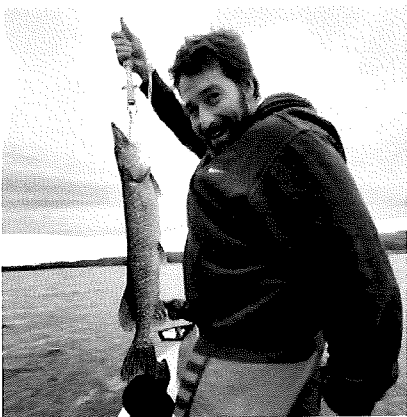

 - Interview: claimed the two were shooting together before the event. [REDACTED] left due to Card's erratic behavior

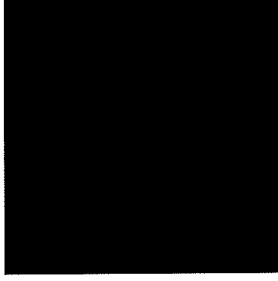
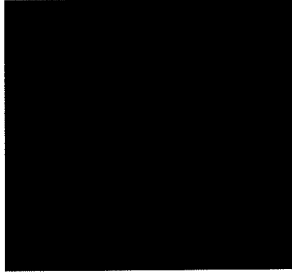
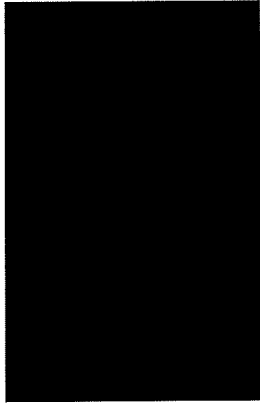
- There is speculation that the truck that was left at the bowling alley (while registered to [REDACTED]) is being used by [REDACTED] [REDACTED] has several guns in it and is still at the bowling alley. The warrant for this truck is underway.

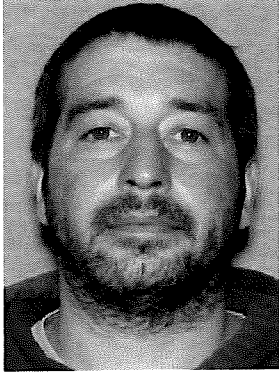

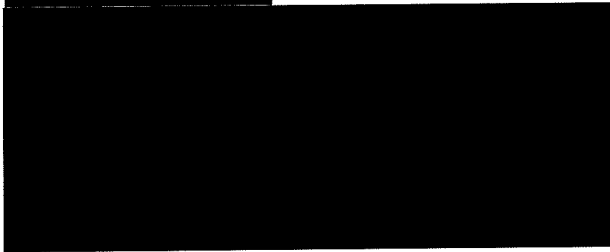
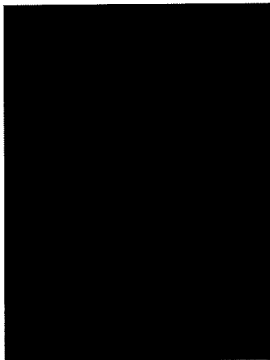

Narrative

On 10/27/2023 the Maine State Police Underwater Recovery Team was requested to search the Sebattus River Reservoir as part of a manhunt search for Robert Card who is the suspect in the two mass shootings in Lewiston on 10/25/2023. Card's white Subaru had been located at the boat launch parking lot just after the shootings.

The Maine State Police Underwater Recovery Team was assigned to search the area of the Sebattus River Reservoir from the area of the boat launch out to the Androscoggin River. Sgt. Stedman was assigned as Dive Supervisor for the operation.

MSP URT Divers (Chavez, Fillmyer, Bachelder, Beauchamp and Adams) conducted pendulum searches from the shore in the areas just north of the boat launch to areas just north of the railroad trestle bridge on the river. Divers utilized metal detectors to assist them at times with the search. The divers were tended on site by Ofc. Kuni, Sgt. Sinclair, and Capt. MacDonald.

The MSP URT also deployed the Underwater Remotely Operated Vehicle (ROV) with its multi-beam sonar into the Sebattus River Reservoir. The ROV was operated by Tpr. Jacob Ferland and he checked the Sebattus River Reservoir utilizing its multi-beam sonar to scan areas of the river in front of the boat launch down to the mouth of the Androscoggin River.

The searches conducted by both divers and the ROV did not turn up any items of interest in the investigation.

Tpr. Peterson was assigned as the medic for the operation and conducted the following checks:

- * St. Marys hyperbaric chamber contacted at 0940 and available.
- * Lifelight contacted at 0942 and available.
- * Lisbon EMS contacted at 0945 via Androscoggin RCC and available.

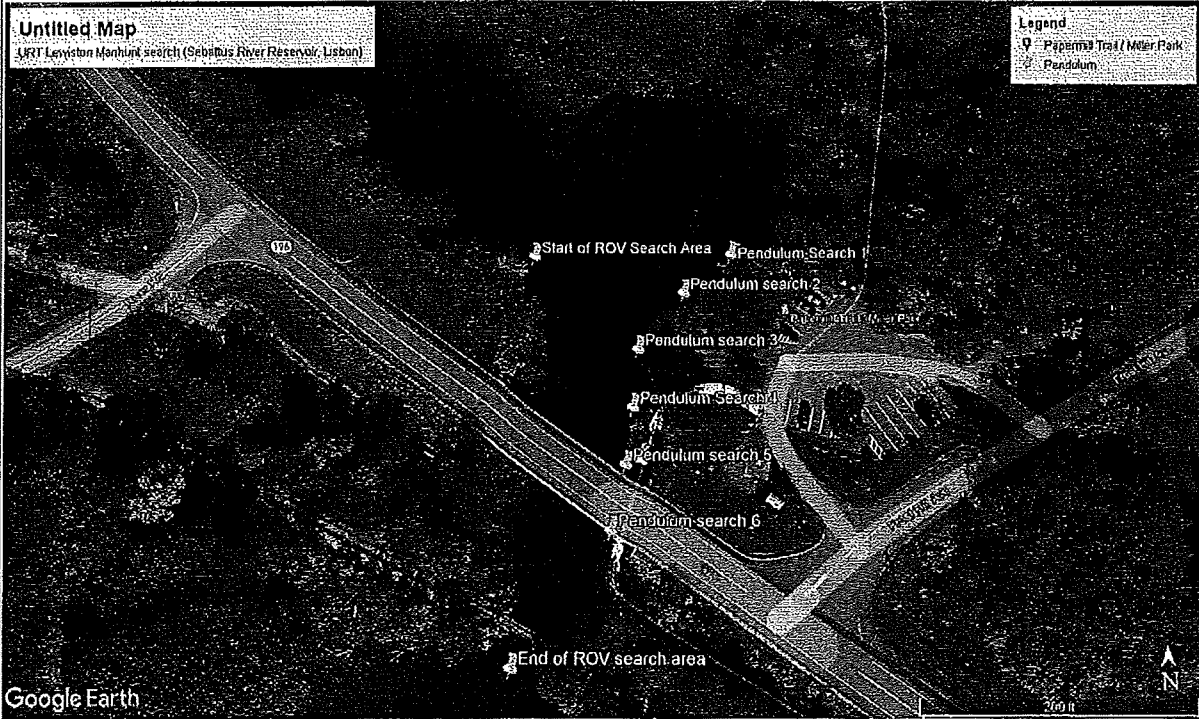
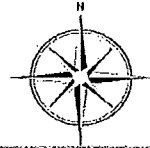

Narrative Report of Sgt. Jarod I. Stedman

On 10/27/2023 I responded with the Maine State Police Underwater Recovery Team to Lewiston to assist with the Robert Card manhunt. The Maine State Police Underwater Recovery Team was requested to search the Sabattus River Reservoir in the area of the boat landing where Robert Cards car had been located the night of the shootings.

As dive supervisor, I conducted a briefing with our team as to the location of the search and the areas of interest. During the brief we discussed any and all hazards that the team could encounter during the operation. It was determined that we would start searching the area of the boat launch on hardwire communication lines utilizing a pendulum search pattern. We also planned to deploy the Remotely Operated Underwater Vehicle (ROV) with sonar to work the area from the boat launch to the mouth of the Androscoggin River. While at the briefing I provided assignments to all members of the URT that were present. During this time I also coordinated with Cpl. Tony Gray and Sgt. Bruce Loring from the Maine Warden Service Dive Team. They agreed to assist us with their ROV and were assigned to search the Hydro dam on the Androscoggin River that was south of our location.

During the dive operation several pundulum searches were conducted and the ROV was utilized to clear out to the mouth of the Androscoggin River. Divers reported very low to zero visibility during the dives.

As we neared the mouth of the Androscoggin River I spoke with Lt. Tyler Stevenson to update him on what we had cleared so far and to see what the URT role would be for the following day. Lt. Stevenson stated that the river from the Sabattus River Reservoir to the hydro dam needed to be cleared. It was asked if our team could clear this tomorrow. Due to the sheer mass of river to be covered it would not be possible for MSP URT to clear the river in one day. I advised Lt. Stevenson that in looking at weather forecast for the next few days that tomorrow was our only good weather day before temperatures drop drastically. I advised Lt. Stevenson that it would be best to gather as many resources as we could for tomorrow and try to utilize optimal weather conditions if we could.

Lt. Stevenson then approved me to coordinate with our NESPAC partners along with New York State Police. I reached out to the following dive teams: (New York State Police, Massachusetts State Police, Connecticut State Police, Vermont State Police, New Hampshire Fish and Game, and the Portland Police Department Dive Teams). I briefed them on the nature of our operation and that we were attempting to utilize side scan sonars to search the river for Robert Card. I received commitments from all of the teams contacted and they confirmed that they would be at the Lisbon boat launch for a 0800 brief on Saturday morning with boats, side scan sonars and divers.

While working on an operational plan for the following morning, Sgt. Loring, Cpl. Gray, Capt. MacDonald and I went out onto the Androscoggin River to view the areas to be searched and begin to mark out grids that could be assigned to teams when they arrived on Saturday morning. After coming off from the river, I briefed the MSP URT members on the following days operation and who was coming to assist.

After briefing our team for the following days operation plan, Tpr. Ferland and I cleaned gear and prepared gear for the following day.

As Tpr. Ferland and I were working on gear we were notified that Robert Card had been located deceased. Lt. Stevenson a short time later advised that I could cancel all resources that we had coming for the Androscoggin River Search. I then reached out to all of the NESPAC teams who had committed to us and requested that they stand down.

Narrative Report of Tr. Caleb Adams

On 10/27/2023 I was assigned as a member of the Maine State Police Underwater Recovery team to assist with the search for the suspect Robert Card in the Lewiston active shooter. I arrived at the command post and waited for Sgt. Stedman to give assignments for our dive operation. We were told that we were waiting for a tac team to clear the boat launch where the suspect's vehicle was found before we arrived at the boat launch.

When we arrived, I assisted with moving gear and setting up the ROV. I was advised that I would be working with Tr. Batchelder and a metal detector to check the area closest to shore. Tr. Batchelder and I used a line from the shore to ensure that we had a consistent search pattern. Tr. Batchelder utilized his chest waders and covered the area that he could just by walking. Sgt. Stedman had me dive under the bridge leading out to the river. I was looking for the suspect. I was tended from the shoreline with a hardwire communication line. I searched under the bridge. It was approximately 12 feet at the deepest point. The water was black, and I had very limited visibility. There was a substantial amount of debris in the water making it very difficult to search the area. I did not find anything in my search. I made it approximately three-quarters of the way across the bridge. After this, I got out of the water and helped clean up the dive site. I cleared from the scene after that.

1. On Friday, October 27, 2023 at approximately 0800 hours, I arrived at the Lewiston High School in Lewiston. I was briefed by the Underwater Recovery Team Commander, Sgt. Jarod Stedman.
2. As a member of the URT, I responded to the Sabattus River public boat landing near the intersection of Frost Hill Ave and Lisbon Street in Lisbon Falls. The boat landing is near the intersection of the Sabattus River and the Androscoggin River. I deployed and operated the Remote Operated Vehicle (ROV) which is a tool that uses multi-beam sonar and video footage, allowing the operator to search an area underwater while remaining on land. I searched the area from approximately 150 feet north east of the boat launch to the area approximately 150 feet into the Androscoggin River from the Sabattus River. I did not locate any items of interest.

Narrative Report of Marine Patrol Officer Kaelyn Kuni

On 10/27/2023 I responded to the City of Lewiston with the Maine State Police Underwater Recovery Team. The team would be searching the Sabattus River Reservoir in part of a manhunt for Robert Card; the suspect of a mass shooting in Lewiston.

We set up equipment at the boat launch where Robert Card's vehicle had been located two days prior.

During the search, I tended the lines for the diver's while they were underwater and maintained communication with them via hard-wired umbilical. The diver's searched using a pendulum pattern. The starting and ending air pressure and time were documented for each diver as they entered and exited the water.

I also tended to Trooper Bachelder while he used a metal detector to search a shallow boggy area close to shore. Trooper Bachelder used a pendulum pattern to search the area starting from the shore.

The Underwater Recovery Team did not locate anything during the search. This concluded my participation in the investigation.

Narrative Report of Andrew Peterson

On October 27th, 2023, I responded to Lewiston in reponse to the manhunt for Robert Card. I arrived at the Lewiston High School staging area and met with members of the URT in the praking lot. We went into the school cafeteria for the morning breifing. Sgt. Stedman got the team's assignment from the command staff and we went out to our team trailer for individual assignments.

Sgt. Stedman advised us that that we would operating the ROV and putting divers in the water at the boat launch where Card's vehicle was found. Sgt. Stedman told us that we were waiting at the staging area until the tactical teams cleared the area around the boat launch for our safety. The diver rotation was given out as were individual assignments.

I was assigned to be the safety officer for the operation and medical. I contacted Life flight and confirmed that they were available and they were. I contacted St. Mary's wound care to confirm that their pressure chamber was operational and it was. I also contacted the local ambulance service and advised them that we were diving and where. While waiting at the staging area we did some minor maintenance and preparation work on our equipment.

We recieved the information that the boat launch area had been cleared and we moved to the boat launch with all our members and equipment. Once on scene, we launched the ROV and started to clear the area immediately adjacent to the boat launch. Det. Ferland operated the ROV while I tended the tether, making sure it did not get tangled. We cleared that area and Sgt. Stedman had us relocate onto the train bridge closer to the main river.

Detective Ferland and I set up the ROV on the edge of train bridge and launched the ROV. We cleared the mouth of the small river out into the main river from there. We did not locate any evidence or bodies in either of our operations.

While we were on the second operation, divers went into the first area we cleared to do a secondary search of the area. Once we had the ROV out of the water and broken down, I assisted in tending the divers who were in the water. The divers also did not locate any evidence or bodies in the river.

I assisted the team in packing up all of gear and we cleared the scene.

Narrative Report of Capt. Colin MacDonald

On October 27, 2023 I was assigned, as a member of the Maine State Police Underwater Recovery team (URT), to take part in the search for Robert Card, who was the suspect in the Lewiston active shooter incident. I arrived at the command post at approximately 0630 hours and waited for other URT members to arrive. Sgt. Stedman advised all URT members that we would be briefed on what our specific tasks were going to be at the command post. After Sgt. Stedman met with the incident commanders, he advised all URT personnel as to their assignments for the dive operation. We were told that we were waiting for a tac team to clear the boat launch where the suspect's vehicle was found before we arrived at the boat launch.

After arriving at the dive location where the suspect's vehicle was found, I assisted with moving equipment and setting up gear for divers. After setting up gear, I assisted Sgt. Bagley and Detective Ferland with deploying the MSP URT ROV in the vicinity of the train trussell, below the dive location. After assisting with the ROV deployment, I worked with Maine Warden Service Sergeant Loring to recover the Warden Service ROV. Their ROV had become lodged against a grate in the Lisbon Dam downriver of our location. After a considerable amount of time and effort we were able to dislodge the ROV from the dam and recover it. After returning to the dive site I, along with Sgt. Stedman, Sgt. Loring, and Corpral Gray, utilized a MWS vessel to look for a suitable boat launch in preparation for the dive and sonar operations scheduled for the following day. After completing this I returned to the dive site where I was debriefed from the day's operations by Sgt. Stedman. I then left the scene.

Narrative Report of Sgt. Matthew Sinclair

On 10/27/23 I was on scene in the area of the boat launch on the Sabattus River Reservoir in Lisbon. I was part of the MSP/MMP Underwater Recovery Team, participating in the underwater search efforts in support of the manhunt for Robert Card. My role was that of surface support, providing assistance and oversight for the diving operations. I assisted Commander Stedman with sight assessment and planning for the operation. I assisted the divers with their gear assembly and donning prior to the dives. Once the divers were briefed and began the dive, I worked in tandem with the tenders, who maintained communications with the divers through specialized underwater communication equipment. I monitored the air supply and status of each of the divers on a regular basis throughout the dive, and assisted with documentation of air consumption and dive times. As the dives were completed, I assisted the divers with egress from the dive site, and disassembly of their equipment.

Our team conducted several briefs with our members throughout the course of the operation, as new information and observations from the divers was relayed. The team adjusted our subsequent dive plans to adjust for the conditions, in an effort to most effectively search the area we were tasked with. A Remote Operated Vehicle was utilized in combination with the divers, using the attached sonar to search the area. No evidence was located during our search of the area from the area of the boat launch downstream to the Androscoggin River. We conducted a thorough team debrief at the completion of the dive operation.

Narrative Report of Tr. Walter Bachelder

On 10/27/23, at 0900 hours, I responded to the Sabattus River Reservoir in Lisbon, with the Maine State Police Underwater Recovery Team. We were responding to this location which was in connection of the two mass shootings that happened in Lewiston. At 1100 hours we started our search for Robert Card and any evidence related to the shooting.

I was assigned to search the shoreline of the reservoir with an underwater metal detector. I searched approximately 10 ft from shore into the water. On the map that is attached to this report, I searched from pendulum 1 search point to pendulum 3 search point. I did not locate any evidence relating to the shooting.

The next objective I was assigned during the search was tending for Tr. Fillmyer. I set up on the shore at pendulum search point 2. I did not move from this location throughout Tr. Fillmyer's search. Tr. Fillmyer was attached to a hardwire communications line. Once Tr. Fillmyer entered the water, she began her pendulum search. Each time Tr. Fillmyer would complete a pass, I would let out 3 feet of the comm line. Tr. Fillmyer did not locate any evidence related to the shooting.

The final objective I was tasked with was to tend for Det. Chavez. I stood in an aluminum warden boat that was attached to shore. Tr. Chavez was attached to a hardwire communication line. I had to stand in the boat due to the shoreline conditions. Once Det. Chavez entered the water, he began his pendulum search. When Det. Chavez was finished with a pass, I would let out three feet of line to expand his search area. During Det. Chavez's search, he did not find any evidence related to the search.

This concludes my involvement.

Narrative Report of Det. Cpl. Michael J. Chavez

Friday, October 27, 2023

At 0800 hours, I arrived at the Lewiston High School to attend a morning briefing with Sgt. Jarod Stedman, Commander of the Underwater Recovery Team. The purpose of the briefing was to develop and implement a plan to search a section of the Sabattus River in Lisbon for Robert Card and other potential evidence; Card was a suspect in a mass shooting event that had occurred on October 25th in Lewiston and his vehicle had been located at the boat launch in Lisbon.

At approximately 1100 hours, I arrived at the boat launch located on Frost Hill Ave, immediately off of Lisbon Street, along with other members of the URT. Sgt. Stedman decided to deploy our underwater remotely operated vehicle (ROV) before divers entered the water. I assisted briefly in-water to help launch the ROV and awaited further instruction.

Det. Jacob Ferland, who operated the ROV, reported that the area was littered with various obstructions and changing terrain, which made operation of the ROV difficult. Sgt. Stedman assigned me to enter the water to conduct a shore tended line search in a "pendulum" pattern directly at the foot of the boat launch.

I searched several sections of the river and did not find Robert Card or anything of evidentiary value. I confirmed what Det. Ferland had observed: the area was littered with dead trees, large boulders, concrete blocks and construction debris. Upon completion of my searches, Tr. Caleb Adams was deployed to search the area adjacent to where I had just been; I transitioned into the role of safety/back-up diver for him.

At approximately 1700 hours, I cleared from the scene.
