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NARRATIVE / GIST

Between October 25, 2023 and October 28, 2023, members of New Hampshire State Police [REDACTED] **responded to assist Maine State Police with a mass shooting investigation to include the search for the suspect, Robert R. CARD** [REDACTED]. The investigation revealed that on October 25, 2023 at approximately 1856 hours, CARD went to Just in Time Recreation in Lewiston, ME and began shooting people at the bowling alley after which he left. Then at approximately 1908 hours, CARD went to Schemengees Bar & Grille where he continued to shoot individuals at the bar. In total, CARD killed 18 people at the above-mentioned locations and injured approximately 13 other individuals. A few hours later, CARD's vehicle which was identified as a white Subaru Outback [REDACTED] was discovered abandoned at a boat landing off the Androscoggin River in Lisbon, ME. On October 27, 2023 at approximately 1900 hours, the body of CARD was located in a trailer close to a recycling center in Lisbon, ME where CARD used to work. [REDACTED]. NARRATIVE

On Wednesday, October 25, 2023, a mass murder occurred at numerous locations in the City of Lewiston, Maine. The suspect, Robert CARD, had reportedly fled the area and his whereabouts were unknown. With such, the New Hampshire State Police [redacted] request by the Maine State Police, to assist [redacted] locating CARD.

On Thursday, October 26, 2023, at approximately 8:00 AM, we briefed at the Lewiston, Maine High School. The school was the designated command post for the duration of the deployment. During our deployment, we were partnered with Maine [redacted]

[redacted] During our missions, I was assigned with my canine partner, K9 Jacob; a [redacted]. Our primary duties were to assist [redacted] from NH and Maine [redacted]

Thursday, October 26th
 Approximately 10:00 AM

Maine SP [redacted] attempting to make contact with any occupants inside of the structure (mobile home). With blue lights activated and the PA hailing, they ultimately popped a window [redacted]. They were [redacted]

also able to pop the man door on the garage on the property. Drones were deployed [redacted] to check the immediate area, [redacted], K9 Jacob and I deployed with an entry [redacted]. I deployed K9 Jacob into the interior [redacted], a blend of Maine and New Hampshire operators flowed the structure, [redacted]. I then utilized K9 Jacob off-lead [redacted]; peeling back the skirt to get the dog underneath as best as possible. This ended my involvement in the matter.


Maine SP [redacted] attempting to make contact with any occupants inside of the structure (cape-style residence with garage attached on left side of structure via a breezeway). Same actions were taken above in the same order. This time, [redacted] popped the right garage door. Members of the Massachusetts State Police [redacted] this deployment, [redacted]. It was discovered during at that time that the interior of the residence was a hoarder-like situation, with goat path-like walkways throughout. [redacted]. When it came time to deploy K9 Jacob, [redacted]. K9 Jacob [redacted] garage and our team flowed into such. K9 Jacob then [redacted] the interior on lead, [redacted] working such [redacted]. Ultimately the structure was cleared (main floor, second floor, basement). This ended my involvement in the matter.

Friday, October 27th
Approximately 10:30 AM

Maine SP [redacted]. Our primary responsibility was the perimeter around a barn and cabin, [redacted]. A large contingent [redacted]. We followed them up there [redacted]. Late Friday evening our team received notification that CARD'S body was located. We returned to New Hampshire from our deployment on Saturday, October 28th. No further action.

The New Hampshire State Police Aviation Unit was immediately requested and deployed to provide overhead support. As the incident progressed and resources were deployed to multiple scenes, it was clear that the search for the suspect could continue into the next day. The Maine State Police [redacted] New Hampshire State Police SWAT Unit respond to Lewiston to assist at 0800 the morning of Thursday, October 26th, 2023.

Upon arrival at the staging area, which was located at Lewiston High School, New Hampshire State Police SWAT Unit leadership attended an informational briefing regarding the status of the investigation.

Investigators reviewed the events of the prior evening and provided information of the suspect who was identified as Robert CARD. CARD was currently wanted on several counts of Murder. After the meeting, New Hampshire State Police SWAT Unit leadership was briefed by Maine State Police [REDACTED] leadership regarding the execution of a Search Warrant at the suspects residence. The suspect's residence was located at [REDACTED] in Bowdoin, Maine. The property included a mobile home with an adjacent two car garage.

NH State Police SWAT Unit Personnel worked in conjunction with Maine State Police [REDACTED] personnel to affect a [REDACTED] search warrant at 1040 hours on Thursday, October 26th, 2023. Upon the deployment of inner perimeter personnel, [REDACTED] began making announcements over the loudspeaker advising their presence and that there was a Search Warrant for the residence. After several opportunities for response, [REDACTED]. NH State Police SWAT Unit personnel then deployed drones [REDACTED]. After those locations [REDACTED] the garage was cleared. A New Hampshire State Police SWAT Unit K9 was then deployed [REDACTED]. Subsequently, the mobile home was cleared by personnel. CARD was not located on the property. The property was then secured and subsequently handed off to personnel to process the scene for evidence.



Just before 1700 hours on Thursday, October 26th, 2023, the New Hampshire State Police SWAT Unit was tasked with another target location that was to be searched in conjunction with the Maine State Police [REDACTED]. The location was identified as the residence of [REDACTED]. The residence was at [REDACTED] in Bowdoin, ME. Maine State Police Investigators received written consent from the homeowner to search the premise. At approximately 1830 hours, New Hampshire State Police SWAT Unit personnel, in conjunction with Maine State Police [REDACTED], responded to [REDACTED]. The media presence on Meadow Rd in the area of the target location was considerable and made inserting perimeter personnel difficult. The bright camera lights were backlighting personnel as they attempted to move into perimeter position undetected. Once perimeter personnel were set the Maine State Police [REDACTED] began loud hailing in the driveway [REDACTED]. After loud hailing for an extended period of time, drones were deployed [REDACTED]. A Massachusetts State Police [REDACTED] sent into the garage through the open bay door. [REDACTED]. It was at about this time that the Maine State Police [REDACTED] was requested to respond to another location to follow up on a lead. A contingent of New Hampshire State Police SWAT personnel [REDACTED] the residence with a K9. The structure was then cleared with personnel. No one was located during the search.

At approximately 0900 hours on Friday, October 27th 2023, the New Hampshire State Police SWAT Unit was tasked with assisting the Maine State Police [REDACTED] with clearing a hunting cabin on [REDACTED] in Sabattus, Maine. The location was believed to be frequented by CARD. Just before 1000 hours, the ATF [REDACTED]. New Hampshire State Police SWAT Unit in conjunction with the Maine State Police [REDACTED] deployed inner perimeter personnel around the cabin and outbuildings. A Maine State Police [REDACTED] loud hailing and then drones were deployed [REDACTED]. Drones were again deployed [REDACTED] interior of the structure. A K9 was used [REDACTED] the

At approximately 2030 hours, it was learned that the Maine State Police [REDACTED] located the subject who was deceased at a recycling facility in Lisbon, Maine. The New Hampshire State Police SWAT Unit returned to New Hampshire during the morning hours of Saturday, October 28th 2023.

At some point during this, we were informed the Maine State Police [REDACTED] was departing the area for another matter. The perimeter units were reassigned to different areas. [REDACTED] remained in place. Continuing with the operation and with no answer or contact from anybody within the residence, several other assets were utilized to check the residence. K9 Ram remained with me at our perimeter position and no contact was made with anybody during this operation. Once the property was deemed safe, we returned to the command post.

On Friday 10/27/2023 at approximately 1030 hours we received a brief for another residence/building to search and locate Card. We responded along with a contingent of Maine State Police [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] the Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) to [REDACTED] Sabattus, ME, a structure on a private road with no numerical address. Upon arrival, the ATF team set out [REDACTED]



With the property contained an attempt to contact Card via loud hail was made. With no answer from anybody, other assets were utilized to check the residence before ultimately being clear for investigators to enter. K9 Ram remained with me at our perimeter position and no contact was made with anybody during this operation. Once the property was deemed safe, we returned to the command post.

Once back at the command post, we remained in a QRF status until being relieved by other teams. Later that evening we were informed that Card had been confirmed located and deceased. This ended my involvement in this case and returned to New Hampshire on Saturday 10/28/2023.
