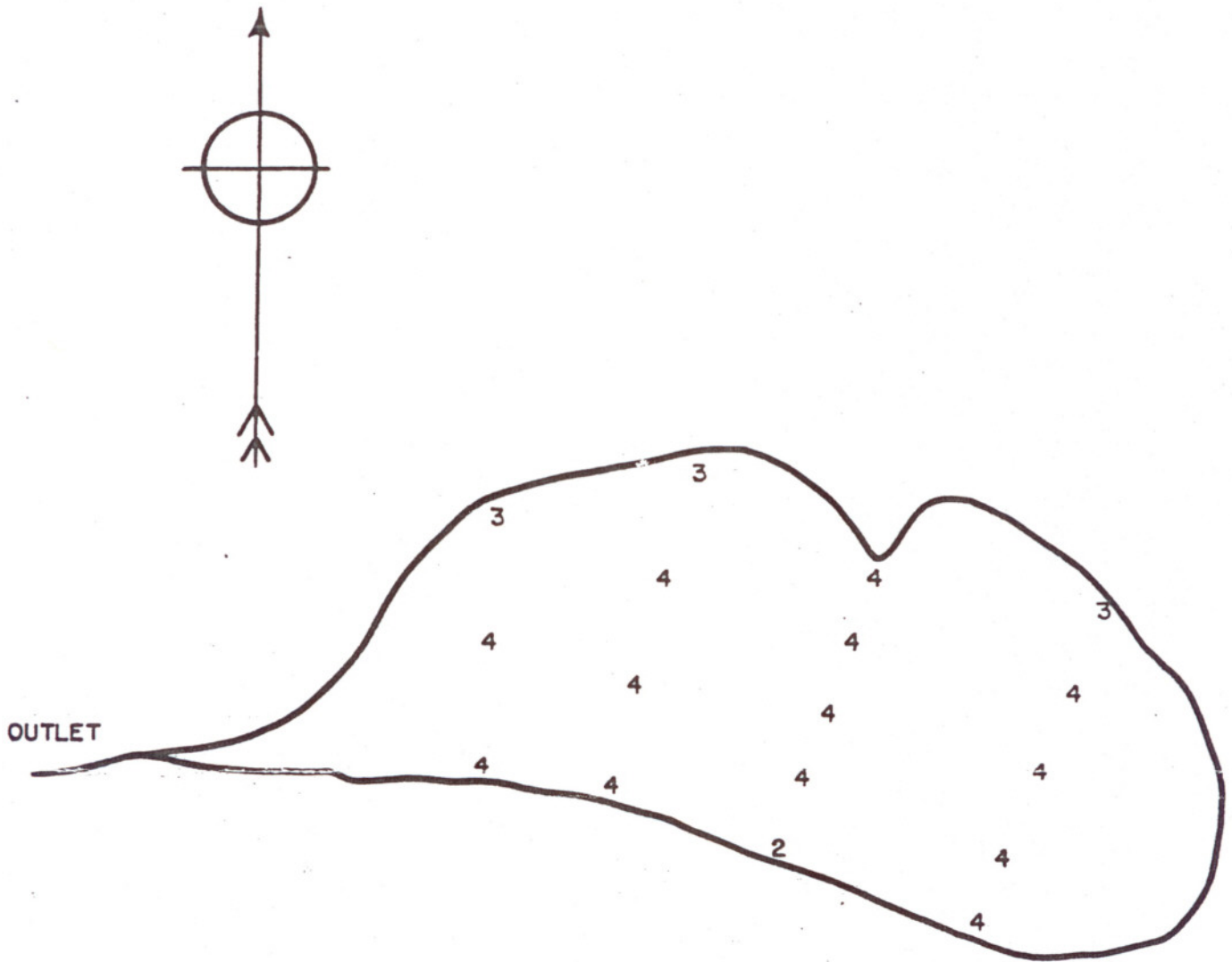
Principal fishery: Brook trout
