# L.D. 455, An Act To Increase the State Earned Income Credit

- The Committee voted on March 11<sup>th</sup> and had a divided report of OTPA/ONTP.
- The amendment changes the proposal for increasing the EITC to 10% of the federal credit rather than 50% as in the original bill and adds an appropriations section for administrative cost.
- As in the original bill, the credit is fully refundable.
- A fiscal note is required.

## Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes an ongoing General Fund appropriation for two additional Tax Examiner positions beginning Jauary 1, 2014 and related administrative support.
