# L.D. 720, "An Act To Eliminate Sales Tax Exemptions for Snowmobiles and Allterrain Vehicles Purchased by Nonresidents for Use in the State"

- The Committee voted on March 18, 2013, and had a divided report of OTPA/ONTP.
- The <u>majority report</u> amended the bill to provide technical clarifications.
- The fiscal note estimates a General Fund revenue increase of \$56,786 in FY14 and \$78,375 in FY 15 as well as increases in municipal revenue sharing.
