Appointment & Termination Instructions

Pursuant to M.R.S. 24-A §1420-M (1), and (2), an insurance producer may not act as an agent of an insurer unless the insurance producer becomes an appointed agent of that insurer. To appoint a producer as its agent, the appointing insurer shall file, in a format approved by the Superintendent, a notice of appointment within 15 days from the date the agency contract is executed, or the first insurance application is submitted.

Please be aware that the State of Maine does <u>**not**</u> require an appointment for branch locations of business entities (agencies). Only the primary location needs to be appointed.

Insurers may appoint individuals and/or business entities using the following two methods:

1) Electronic Submissions: The Bureau is a participating state in the National Insurance Producer Registry's Electronic Appointment/Termination system. 2) Paper Submissions: For paper submissions, insurers must use the Appointment/Termination form found on our website at <u>Insurers | PFR Insurance (maine.gov)</u>. No confirmation of appointment will be sent to the insurer. Confirmation that the Bureau of Insurance has received and processed the appointment(s) can be verified on our website at <u>Licensee Search | PFR Insurance (maine.gov)</u>.

Special Note: Please do not submit the appointment form with applications for licensure. The form is to be submitted <u>after</u> the individual/business entity has become licensed.
